## **SUMMARY OF DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

To assist with the eradication of breeding sites of mosquitoes as well as eggs, larvae, pupae and adult pests of Public Health importance, throughout the Parishes of Kingston and St. Andrew, including the Cays

## **Key Out Puts**

- Survey Household premises and collect data on pests including rodents
- Collection of samples of mosquito larva from rivers, drains, ponds, pools and other settlements of water.
- Oiling infested areas
- Fogging of infested areas
- Auxiliary functions at the Health Department/and other facilities.

## **KEY RESPONSIBILITY AREAS**

### **Larvicidal Management of Mosquitoes:**

- Search, identify and destroy mosquitoes, eggs, larva and pupa.
- Do routine checks of all household in the parish on a timely manner as directed by supervisor and report on identified breeding sites.

### **Adulticidal Management:**

- Fog designated communities on a routine basis and whenever special requests are made.

### **Rodent Control:**

- Identify areas of harborage of rats
- Preparation and administration of rat-baits

### **General Pest control:**

- Search identify and destroy other pests of Public Health importance
- Spraying of Health facilities and other Government buildings which have become infested as the need arises.

### **Occasional/Special Assignments:**

- Assist with auxiliary functions at the Health Department/Health Centres and other facilities as it becomes necessary.
- Assist with disaster preparedness and recovery
- Any other duties as assigned.

## **PERFORMANCE STANDARD**

- Sixteen (16) sites are to be visited by each team on a daily basis.
- Fifteen (15) household are to be visited by each person on a daily basis.

**Education/Qualification** - *Must* be literate or have completed secondary school

## **Required Skills**

- Good written and oral communication skills.
- Ability to function appropriately under stressful conditions.
- Ability to prioritize assigned tasks.
